**PATHWAYS TO PEACE** is LCC International University's commitment to students whose lives have been shattered by war, offering not only financial support but also safety, belonging, and renewed hope. Through scholarships, need-based aid, and emergency assistance, students can continue their education and begin rebuilding their futures.

The funds raised through Cycle 5 to Survive have made a significant impact across multiple academic years. LCC is deeply grateful to P.L. and Kristen for their partnership, generosity, and belief in the mission of Pathways to Peace, which makes this life-changing support possible.

## 2024–2025 Academic Year

---

During the 2024–2025 academic year, Pathways to Peace supported students from some of the world's most vulnerable regions:

- 9 students from Afghanistan and Iraq received scholarships totaling €8,808.75, enabling them to continue their studies despite the ongoing impact of war in their home countries.
- 1 Ukrainian student received €648 in emergency aid after his family's apartment building was destroyed by a missile strike and his father sustained permanent injuries. This support covered his final tuition installment, allowing him to remain enrolled during a time of severe crisis.
- 25 students from Ukraine received need-based aid totaling €47,638.50, covering 40% to 60% of their tuition fees. As many families were displaced or forced to flee the country, this assistance made an LCC education accessible during an extremely difficult period.

In total, €57,095.25 was distributed during the 2024–2025 academic year to help students from conflict-affected regions continue their education. Because of C5TS, 35 students affected by war were able to continue their education this academic year.

## 2025–2026 Academic Year

---

Support continues to be critically needed in the 2025–2026 academic year as conflicts persist and families struggle to rebuild their lives.

- 5 students from Afghanistan and Iraq received scholarships totaling €5,946.92, providing essential assistance for their continued higher education.
- 29 students from Ukraine received need-based aid totaling €47,637.27. With many families still displaced and unable to return home, this support covered 30% to 60% of tuition costs. As some



families began securing employment in new countries, slightly adjusted award amounts allowed funds to be shared with a greater number of students in need.

In total, €53,584.19 has been distributed during the 2025–2026 academic year. Because of C5TS, 34 students affected by war were able to continue their education this academic year.

Over these two academic years, €110,679.44 (nearly 170,000 CAD) was provided through scholarships and financial aid, ensuring that students affected by war could remain at LCC International University and continue building a future despite immense challenges.

To reference the full 3 years of support from C5TS: In the 2023–2024 academic year, €59,501 (81,479.36 CAD) was allocated to support 40 students from conflict-affected regions (full report provided January 2025).

Thus, over the past three academic years, Cycle 5 to Survive has contributed 251,090.31 CAD to the Pathways to Peace program, providing vital support for students whose education has been impacted by war.
